KEY SCRIPTURES & QUESTIONS

1. **Read 2 Chronicles 20:1-4**
 - What threat came against Jehoshaphat, the king of Judah? What made the threat so serious?
 - Have you ever been in a situation where you felt like the world was against you? Explain? How did you respond?
 - What was Jehoshaphat's response?
 - Was Jehoshaphat's fear okay? What is the difference between this reaction and long-term fear?
 - Explain the words 'seek the Lord' in your own words. What does a person do to get from the fear stage to the 'seek the Lord' stage?
2. **Read 2 Chronicles 20:13-19**
 - How did God speak to Jehoshaphat? How does God speak to His people today?
 - Has there ever been a time when a friend spoke a specific word of encouragement that had a big impact in your life? Explain?
 - What instructions did God give to the King? Was this easy or hard to follow?
3. **Read 2 Chronicles 20:16-23**
 - So how did the King respond to the Lord's order? Did he do it?
 - Is it hard for you to trust? Even trust God, sometimes?
 - Why are praise and declarations of God's greatness so important during such critical times?
4. **Read 2 Chronicles 20:29-33**
 - What areas of your life have been hard to entrust to the Lord?
 - Are there things in your life that you're holding on to that the Lord has asked you to remove?
