 - Do you usually Imitate?
 - Do you usually Separate?
 - Do you usually Infiltrate?
2. 1 Thessalonians 5:4-11
 - As believers, should we be surprised that the Lord is coming back?
 - How does knowing the Lord is returning affect your everyday life?
 - How does knowing the Lord is returning affect the people you are around every day?
 - When was the last time you had a Christ-centered conversation with someone outside of the church (shared your story, prayed with someone, invited them to church, etc.)?
